Consultant's Report

Mr. Tarkington stated the FAA is continuing with the design and mitigation work for the parallel taxiway extension project. It was noted that hopefully with things moving on time as they are, by first Quarter of 2023 bids will be requested and September – October of 2023 construction can begin.

The fire alarm box has one line with a problem which is due to have the assessment and repair done. The emergency portion to contact the fire department is in good operation.

A list for emergency contacts for the airport was discussed and it was confirmed that Mr. Evans is the first in line of contact as the Manager. At his authorization, others in line to contact would be notified as needed.
