

## Physician's Statement

In order to qualify for Tax Relief for the Disabled in Essex County, VA, it is necessary to either be certified as disabled through the Social Security Administration or other government agency, or to have this letter completed and signed by two physicians.

One physician must have examined you and made this determination of disability, whereas the second certification can be from a physician who has just reviewed your files.

If the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) certifies that you are permanently and totally disabled, you can use VA Form 21-0172 instead of the physician's statement.
